#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Throughout the term, we will continue to work towards developing positive relationships with adults and our friends, We will work on developing confidence when meeting unfamiliar people. We will develop an understanding of why rules are important to follow.



Numbers, numbers, numbers!

Numbers are all around us and this term, Nursery will be developing our understanding of quantity. We will be working with numbers up to 5; counting sets of objects and matching to the correct numeral.

We will be focusing on understanding positional language, using on, under, front and behind.



#### Understanding the World

During this term, we will plant seeds and find out how to care for plants. We will learning about the life cycle of a plant and a chicken. We will thinking about how to care for our natural environment and all living things.

Please ask your child what they are learning about each week. It is going to be very exciting!

#### **Expressive Arts** and Design

In Nursery we will enjoy imaginative play in our Garden Centre Cafe role play area and our small world exploration zone. We will focus on adding more detail to our drawings. We will be singing to melodies and familiar song.

Welcome back to Nursery, to our exciting Summer Term. This term we will explore the topics "In the Garden" and "Under the Sea". We will be spending a lot of time outside so please remember appropriate clothing, a sunhat and your sun-cream.



#### Physical Development



### Communication, Language and Literacy

During this term we will focus on our listening and communication skills. We will be encouraged to articulate our thoughts in long phrases and sentences.

We will read and discuss a range of texts including - Theres a Tiger in the Garden,

Ladybug. We will also continue to practise forming the letters in our names.



It's a great way for us to celebrate those all important moments in Nursery as well as send vital messages of term dates and reminders.










#### The Essentials

- Nappies and wipes






