Mathematics

During this term, we will be developing our sense of self. Learning all about our new friends, our feelings and our environment.

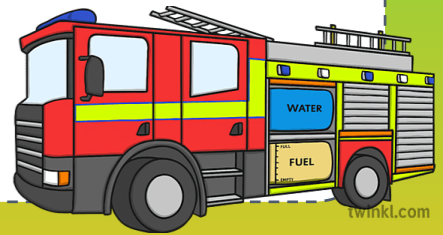
We will be learning all about our families and how all families are different. If we could ask you to either bring in a picture or draw a picture of your family, this would be a wonderful way to get to know you!

Communication, Language and Literacy

During this term the focus will be learning to develop the love of books and building listening skills to be able sit and enjoy them. We will read and discuss a range of texts including – "life is a rainbow", "We are Welcome", "My Mom and Dad make me laugh" and "We are going on a Bear Hunt" Reading books and being read to develops your imagination and increases your vocabulary!
