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School Uniform

Children and staff are very proud of our school uniform, which all children from Reception to Year 6 wear. Please ensure all uniform is clearly marked or labelled with your child's name. Children starting Reception are provided with a school sweatshirt/cardigan by the school along with a red P.E Polo t-shirt and Reading bag.



Jewellery

Jewellery is not to be worn. This includes rings, bracelets, and necklaces. If your child has pierced ears they should wear small stud earrings only. This is for reasons of health and safety.

Inappropriate Items for School

Black/grey sweatshirts, trainers, boots, open-toed sandals, heeled shoes, leggings or jeans are not acceptable and are not to be worn to school.

Hair styles

All pupils should have appropriate hair styles. Extreme hair styles e.g. severely shaved heads, inappropriate logos in hair/patterns, dying of hair is not permitted. Pupil's braids should be in a **natural** colour please.
