### Literacy

This term we will be focusing on superhero stories.



#### PE. Dance and Music

#### Understanding the World

During our UW sessions, we will be looking at the past and present, practising our map reading skills, and looking at the similarities and differences between various areas of the wider world.

### Numeracy

We will be using our mathematical skills to solve problems based

around doubling, halving and sharing. As the

children have become more confident with numbers we will be looking at numbers to 20 and recognising even and odd numbers.

By the end of the Summer Term your child should be able to apply their knowledge of maths to a range of scenarios.

#### RE

This term we will be exploring the question: 'Why is the word of God so important?' We will be exploring who 'God' is for different religions and will look at what each 'God' created.

#### **Phonics**

This half term we will be focusing on Phase 4 phonics. This means that we will be supporting your child in consolidating what they already know, writing longer sentences using a variety of irregular words.
