



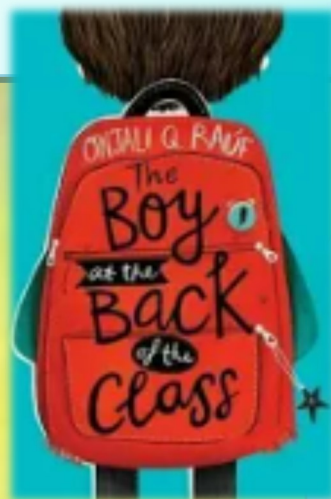
Year 4 are looking forward to a sensational Summer!

Art

In Art, we will be exploring the artist Monet, who uses inspiration and influence from nature to create impressionist pieces of art work. We will create our own art in his style using different techniques, creating pieces based on animals and nature to link in with science and humanities.

Literacy

In Literacy, we will explore the text: 'The Boy at the Back of the Class', about a group of classmates who befriend a boy who joins their class as a refugee. We develop our inference skills, and explore main themes in detail. We will complete various writing activities, including character descriptions, formal letters and poems.



Humanities

Our History topic will see us exploring what life was like in Ancient Greece. We will create timelines, compare city states, create job adverts for a Greek soldier as well as debating about significant leaders and events.

In Geography, we will explore rivers, seas and waters. We will look at the journey of a river and what happens when a river meets the sea. We will consider rivers within the UK and across the world, comparing and contrasting them.

Science

In science, children will explore the digestive system by considering the journey that food takes through the body, starting with the teeth. We will recreate the digestive system to investigate how the body digests food, before exploring the diets and characteristics of a herbivore, carnivore and omnivore.

We will then explore habitats in our local area, considering how they might have changed. We will explore the impact of environmental changes as well as natural disasters that happen in the world. Finally, we will develop our knowledge of climate change, and consider the negative effects of this. We will think about what we can do to help and care for our planet.



Numeracy

Children will explore how to round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. We will also explore how Roman Numerals are used and organised. We will continue to strengthen our understanding of the 4 operations, and will develop our understanding of numbers before zero and fractions.



P.E and Dance

We will be participate in a range of team sports this term, such as net and ball games to learn new skills and develop existing ones. In Dance, we will be exploring dance styles from around the world, interpreting rhythms and using musical accompaniments.

R.E

This term, we will build on our understanding of Islam and the importance of the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH). We will also explore holy books, including the Qu'ran, and consider the stories and messages within them. We will then learn about the different places of worship and how a variety of religions share and celebrate their beliefs.



P.S.H.E

In the summer term, we will consider our behaviour and how it impacts us and those around us. We will also explore how choices that we make now might impact us in the future. We will consider ways of keeping ourselves safe in different situations, and will also look at how our bodies change as we grow up.
