

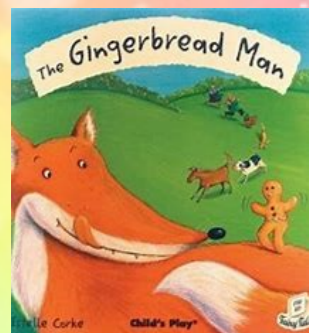
Our Journey Through Spring Term Looks Very Exciting!

Spring 2023

Literacy

This term our focus will be the topic of 'Traditional Tales.' The children will have an opportunity to explore a range of stories and poems and even create their own.

We will be expecting the children to start using irregular 'tricky words' in their writing and beginning to write simple sentences, using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



Science

In Spring term, children will have the opportunity to explore materials, investigate their properties and assess their suitability for purpose. Children will then find the best material for the 'Three Little Pigs' to build with.



Worship

In worship we will be listening to bible stories, such as 'The Lost Sheep.' We will also be learning about various celebrations, in the lead up to Easter.



PE, Dance and Music

In the Spring term the children will continue to develop their multi-skills, including throwing, catching and rolling.

The children will build on their dance and imaginative skills by taking on the role of a character.



Outdoor Learning

This year we will be taking part in the Big Garden Birdwatch. This will involve observing and monitoring the birds in our local area. We will also be making our own bird feeders.

Linking to our PSHE Topic 'Dreams and Goals' we will also be using our skills to make a dreamcatcher from natural components.



Numeracy

We will be using our mathematical skills to measure, height and length. Over this half term, we expect your child to secure their numbers to 20 this involves counting and recognising numbers out of sequence.

The children will be exposed to addition and subtraction calculations, which they will work out using practical methods.



PSHE

This term we will be exploring our dreams and goals, understanding how to persevere when tackling challenges. Later in the term, we will be exploring how we look after our bodies and the importance of exercise and a healthy diet.

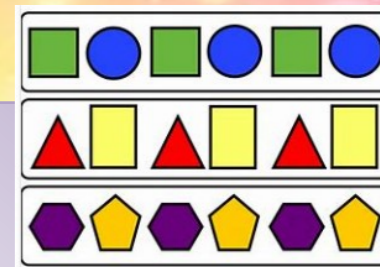

Reading Diary

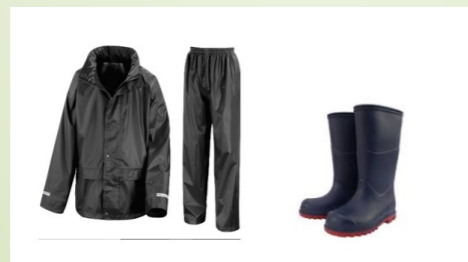
Please could you read with your child at least twice a week. After reading with your child please write in their reading diary. High frequency word cards will also be sent home this term, please assist your child in practising these.

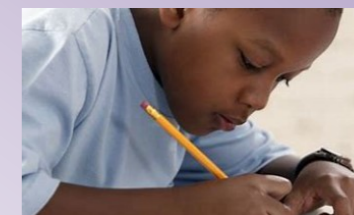

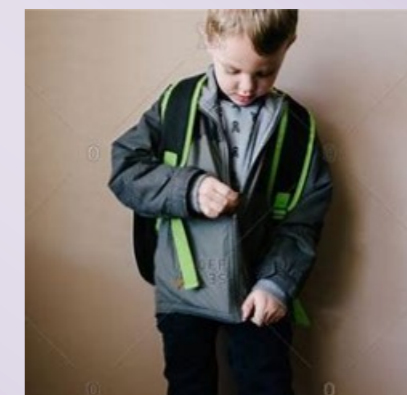
Other Information
