Welcome to our journey of learning in Early Explorers!

Summer 2023

Literacy

This term in Early Explorers our focus in literacy will be around the topics of 'On The Farm' and 'Under The Sea.' The children will learn about a range of fiction and non-fiction books surrounding these two topics.

During our literacy sessions the children will focus on one specific book per week and the continuous provisions set for that week will be based upon the chosen book, the children will cover a wide range of the curriculum and focus their developments around communication and language.

Physical Development

In the summer term children will continue to take part in physical development and movement sessions with Mrs Kowalchuk. The children will continue to learn about different methods of travelling; walking, running, hopping, skipping, jumping etc. The children will also have the opportunity to use the soft play equipment and other apparatus to support their progression in physical development. During these sessions a big focus on taking turns, listening and following instructions is also focused on to help the children's progression and development in PSED.







Outdoor Learning and Adventures

Children in Early Explorers will begin their outdoor learning session during the Summer Term. Parents will be told the dates in which these sessions will begin. Please see page 2 regarding information on clothing for these sessions.

The children have daily access to their outdoor environments and have access to a range of outdoor learning opportunities. The various outdoor arear at school are used during child initiated play which allows the children to participate in a range of learning activities and experiences in the outdoor environments.

ematical topics such as numbers and shape, space and measure. Children

will have the opportunity to use a range of objects within the setting to help scaffold their learning in maths. The children will begin by learning the four basic 2D shapes and numbers up to 5.




During this term the children will continue to learn about music and using instruments to create sounds. The children will be focusing on making sounds with instruments and looking at how we might use these instruments to support our singing. This half term our focus songs are based on classic nursery rhymes about farm animals.



Communication and Language

During the summer term we will be focusing on their listening and attention skills. The children will develop and explore various environmental sounds, animals sounds and transport sounds. We will be developing our

understanding of simple questions about who, what and where.
