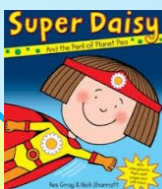


# Our Journey Through Summer Term Looks Very Exciting in Reception!



## Literacy

This term we will be focusing on superhero stories. We will be thinking of the qualities of being heroes and villains through various texts, like Supertato and Super Daisy. We will also be exploring the topic of Under the Sea and reading a selection of texts like Sharing a Shell and Julian is a Mermaid, where we will be exploring texts that celebrate diversity, looking at how people are unique whilst celebrating our differences.



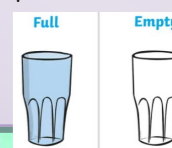
## Expressive Art and Design

This term we are going to be celebrating the King's coronation. We will be making a selection of crafts to decorate and celebrate the occasion. We will also be completing a DT project comprising of the skill weaving.



## Numeracy

This term our focus is on number bonds to 5 and 10. We will be using our mathematical skills to solve problems based around doubling, halving and sharing. We will also be exploring and using money. As the children become more confident with numbers we looking at numbers to 20 and recognising even or odd numbers. We will also be investigating and using mathematical language linked to position, as well as and capacity.



## PE, Dance and Music

In Dance we will learn to move in different ways in time to music. We will be practising ball skills and learning how to move in different ways, using our muscles.

Finally, in Music sessions we will be creating our own melodies and songs.



## RE/ Worship

This term we will be discussing 'Why is the word God so important to Christians' and other faiths. We continue to talk about and share special times that we celebrate. We will be listening to various Bible stories including The Creation Story.



## Our Local Community

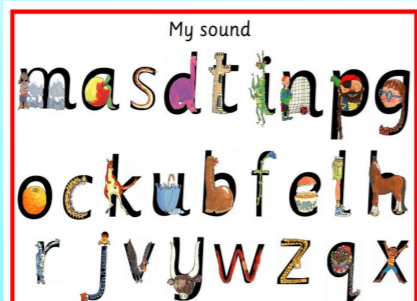
We will be learning about and celebrating our local community, by having special visits from the fire services and our local Police officers.



## Phonics

This half term we will continue to develop our phonics and early reading skills. We will be using Fred fingers for counting and blending sounds when making words. We will also continue practising and learning our Reception words.
