




Our journey through the Summer term looks very exciting in Year 2!





Literacy

During the Summer term, children will study a range of texts including fiction, poetry and stories set in fantasy worlds. Whilst studying these texts they will develop both their reading and writing skills. Children will compete an in-depth comprehension lesson each week focusing on specific reading skills. They will also develop their writing skills by writing for a range of audiences and purposes, including narratives, instructions, letters, non chronological reports and setting descriptions.





Numeracy

In Maths we will be revisiting the skills that the children have learnt so far such as the main four operations, place value and number. We will also consolidate our knowledge of multiplication and division and the rules of commutativity. In summer 2 will we be looking at statistics and how to interpret data.





<u>Humanities</u>

In Humanities during Summer 1, the children will be looking at oceans and coasts, looking at British beaches and then comparing them to non -British beaches. They will also look at how they have changed over time due to factors such as erosion.

In summer 2, we will be learning about significant people who made outstanding achievements in their lifetime. We will be exploring the lives of Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell. We will be creating timelines, making fact files and having debates.







Computing

In Summer I, we will be learning about the process of creating music online and how to layer different instruments to create a piece of music digitally.

In Summer 2, the children will be learning to present data in different ways, including presentations, fact files and quizzes.

In R.E we will be learning about Islam. We will explore the different stories which are included in the Qur'an and discuss what events started the celebration of Ramadan and Eid al Fitr.

In Summer 2, we will be exploring holy places of different religions and explore what it means to have a special place.

Science


In Summer I, we will be looking at animals including humans. We will be looking at the life cycle of an animal and a human to find similarities and differences. Then we will be exploring our basic needs for survival and how to stay healthy. This includes how to stay clean and why it is important. We will also be looking at how exercise can help us keep our heart and body healthy by doing a set of experiments.

In Summer 2, we will be learning about farming, food chains and discuss how animals transfer energy. We will complete our unit by harvesting the food we have grown in allotments and think about what nutrients and energy our healthy snacks provide.

PSHE.

In PSHE this term, we will be looking at respectful relationships. We will look at the different relationships children have such and family and friends. We will also be looking at different members of the community and how they can help us.







Reminders/Notices

Homework

Children need to complete their homework and bring it into school each Friday. Spelling tests are every Friday and children will then receive their new spellings. These should then be learnt for the following week.

Reading

Children are heard with their reading books at least once every 2 weeks in school individually, and as a group. We ask that your child reads at home as frequently as possible, with their Reading Diary updated. This will have a significant impact on their understanding and fluency. It is beneficial for the children to access a wide range of different texts, and we would encourage them to read things that they find interesting.

PE Kit

Year 2 PE is on a Wednesday; on this day, children are to come to school dressed in their PE kit. Children can come in an appropriate coloured tracksuit during the colder weather.

Bug Club and times tables rocks tars

Bug Club is an online library of books that are tailored to your child's reading ability. There are questions along the way to check your child's understanding. Children also now have access to Times tables rock stars which is an online game to help practice their times tables. Their log in details can be found in their reading diary.
