Our School Uniform

Governors and staff are very proud of our school uniform, which all children from Reception to Year 6 wear. Please make sure all uniform is clearly marked or **labelled with your child's name**. Children starting in Reception have been provided with a school sweatshirt/cardigan, a red P.E t-shirt and also their first reading bag.

Jewellery

Jewellery is not to be worn to school. This includes rings, bracelets, and necklaces. If your child has pierced ears they should wear small stud/sleeper earrings only. This is for reasons of health and safety. If there are cultural or religious reasons why your child should wear a particular piece of jewellery, please make an appointment to see the Executive Headteacher or Head of School.

Inappropriate Items for School

Black/grey sweatshirts, trainers, boots, open-toed sandals, heeled shoes, leggings or jeans are not acceptable and are not to be worn to school.

Hair styles:

All pupils should have appropriate hair styles. Extreme hair styles e.g. severely shaved heads, inappropriate logos in hair/patterns, dying of hair is not permitted. Pupils' braids should be in a natural colour please.

School Bags:

Large oversized sports bags are being brought into school. They are not necessary and pupils do not require them. All stationery items are provided by school. Lunch boxes or reading materials and homework books can be placed in smaller satchels.
