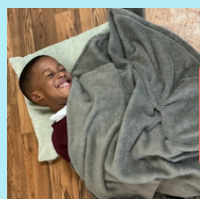

Year 1 have used balance scales to compare the weight of different objects and discover which one was the heaviest



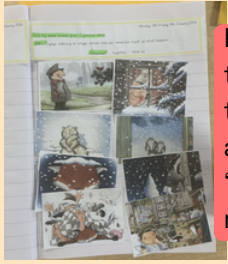
This week, Year 2 created freeze frames and thought bubbles to show the thoughts and feelings of Hansel and Gretel at different points of the fairytale.

As part of Year 3's Ancient Egyptian Workshop, children had the chance to hold a special relic that was 3,000 years old!



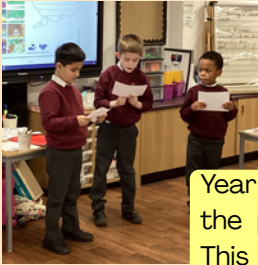
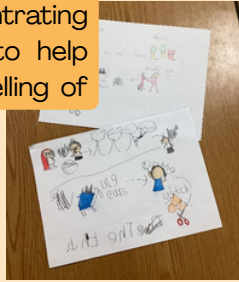
Year 4 spoke with Mr Perrin, discussing the story of Abraham and what it is like to follow God. The children asked some thought-provoking questions!

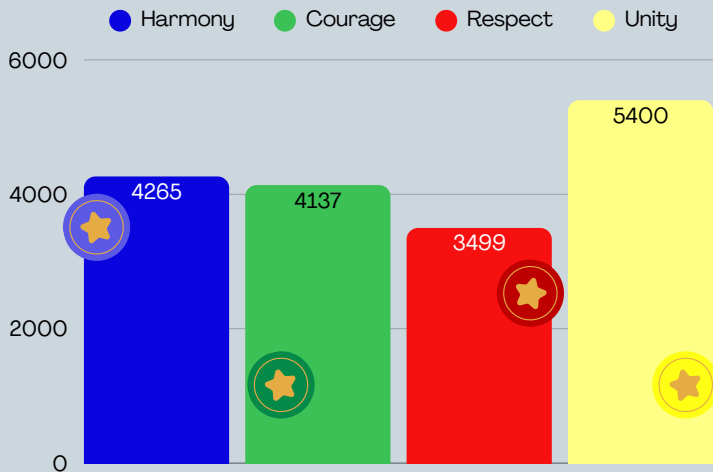


Year 2 explored parables and acted out the parable of the prodigal son in RE. This taught us that God is forgiving like the father in the story.
