Reception have continued to learn about different people who can help us. This week, the children have been roleplaying as nurses, firefighters and doctors




Year 1 had a lot of fun learning new skills outdoors during their Wild Tribes sessions!


Year 5 wrote their own scripts including stage directions and a monologue. They had lots of fun considering the thoughts and feelings of the characters.
